(Red) Tierra Antica Cabernet Sauvignon Central Valley – Chile

(Red) La Croisade Réserve Merlot 2009 Vin de Pays d'Oc – France

With a lively bouquet of plum, blueberry and hints of blackcurrant the palate is beautifully rounded, soft and juicy – sold out fast in 2010!

(White) Pinot Grigio IGT Venezia "Folino Capito!" - Italy

Fresh zesty nose with lime and lemon fruit, ripe pear and melon too. It's crisp and clean and not complex, but as a quaffer it's very tasty. Sold out quickly in 2009 and 2010 - universally liked by all!!

(White) La Tour de Marrenon Côtes du Luberon – France

A wonderful combination of the fat, ripe peachy Grenache Blanc and the floral, aromatic and spicy Vermentino grapes, create a fresh and citrusy medium dry wine. Became known as "the French one" in 2010 and sold out!

(Rosé) Torres Viña Sol Rosé 2010 Catalunya – Spain

Produced by the most famous winery of the region this dry and delicate rosé, has an emphasis on freshness and lightness of fruit.
